The origins of the **Providence Mandolin Orchestra** can be traced back to performances in the first decades of the twentieth century with Giuseppe Pettine and William Place Jr. The modern version of the PMO dates from 1971, when it was revived by Hibbard Perry. Since then the PMO has become one of the leading American mandolin ensembles with regular performances throughout the eastern United States and Western Europe. PMO Music Director **Mark Davis** began his guitar and mandolin studies with Hibbard Perry and continued with Siegfried Behrend from whom he inherited his fascination with contemporary forms of musical expression.
