PROVIDENCE MANDOLIN ORCHESTRA

The mandolin is a very old instrument of the lute family and has a distinct tone color of its own -- shimmering, delicate and unique. Composers such as Beethoven, Vivaldi, Mozart and Verdi have written for it.

The mandolin orchestra consists of mandolin, mandola, mando-cello, mando-bass and guitar and is capable of producing music of a very high artistic standard. Other instruments, such as the banjo for fortissimo, woodwinds and percussion, may be added to the orchestra for color variation.

The Providence Mandolin Orchestra has been organized for only a relatively short period of time but is gradually becoming an important part of the cultural life of our community.
